DEATH NOTIFICATIONS

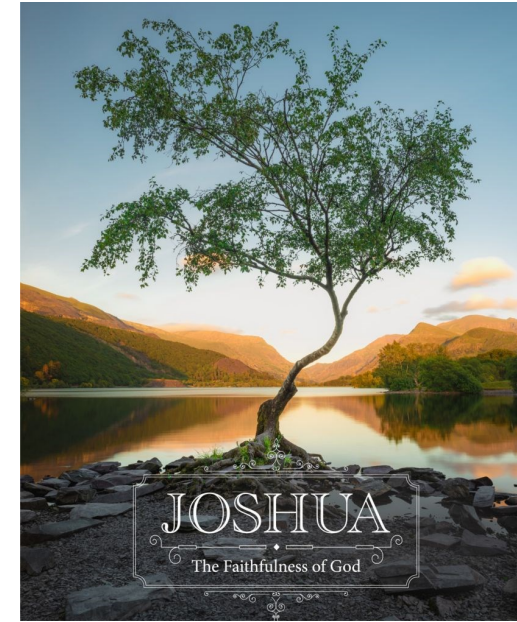
Our website has a form available to anyone for notifying the church of a death. The form is located under the **Resources** tab. We hope this will help expedite communication when there is a death of a family member or a member.

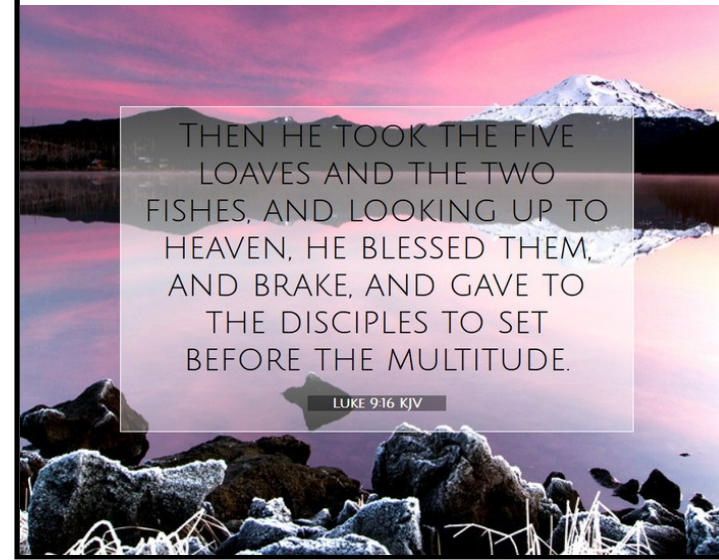
